**SURVEY OF BOATS (APPLICATION) ORDER.**  
*made by the Governor in Council under section 3.*

- Appointment of Surveyors.
1. This Order may be cited as the Survey of Boats (Application) Order in Council.

2. The Survey of Boats Ordinance shall apply to the areas of the ports and inland waters specified in the first column of the Schedule hereto and described in the First and Second Schedules to the Ports and Inland Waters Ordinance.

3. The officers mentioned in the second column of the Schedule hereto are hereby appointed Surveyors to examine boats within the respective ports and inland waters.
