CHAPTER 262.

CURRENCY NOTES (WEST AFRICAN BOARD) (LEGAL TENDER).

An Ordinance to make Currency Notes issued by the West African Currency Board Legal Tender in Sierra Leone. 15 of 1918.
20 of 1936.

[23RD NOVEMBER, 1918.]

1. This Ordinance may be cited as the Currency Notes (West African Board) (Legal Tender) Ordinance, and shall apply to the Colony and Protectorate. Short title.

2. All currency notes issued by the West African Currency Board under the authority of the Currency Notes Ordinance of Nigeria, 1916, shall be current in Sierra Leone, and shall be legal tender in Sierra Leone for the payment of any amount. West African

3. Currency Notes made legal tender in Sierra Leone by this Ordinance shall be deemed to be bank notes within the meaning of the Forgery Acts, 1913 and 1935, and to be valuable securities within the meaning of the Larceny Act, 1861. West African
